All children 0-18 must have a completed registration form in order to receive their wristband for the Clambake Dinner Reception, and badge for the remainder of the convention.

Newport Nannies staff does not administer or assist in the administration of any medications.

Newport Nannies has provided their own Release Form, attached as page 3, which needs to be signed separate from the NECTA release form.

***YOUTH RELEASE:** I hereby give permission and authorize Newport Nannies to allow my child, who is 14 years and older, to sign themselves and/or a younger sibling, out of the children's area to use the restrooms and/or visit the main adult tent area. Otherwise, no child under the age of 14 will be allowed to leave the children's area without the authorization of the parent or guardian. - ❑ Newport Nannies, LLC does not administer medication. To ensure a safe and fun-filled environment, any child who is ill will not be admitted to the program.
- ❑ Please label your child's belongings. We will maintain a lost and found, however, Newport Nannies, LLC does not accept responsibility for the loss or theft of any toy, book, or other personal items.
- ❑ All parents will be required to check-in their child at arrival at the appropriate area and fill out a wristband for their child/children to wear at all times. Likewise all parents must check-out their child/children at the same area for pick-up. The only exception is for children ages 14 and over and their siblings (see paragraph below).

The client understands that by signing this consent form, they indemnify and hold harmless Newport Nannies, LLC, and its owners, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, demands, suits, cost and charges in connection with or arising out of childcare services, including but not limited to, loss, bodily harm, personal injury, death, or property damage occurring while the child/children is/are in the care of Newport Nannies, LLC. Newport Nannies, LLC reserves the right to refuse service for any family at any time.
